#### MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. <u>10</u> SERIES OF 2020

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING TEMPORARY MINIMUM FARE OF TRICYCLE FOR HIRE DURING PANDEMIC IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYAMBANG, PANGASINAN.

Sponsored by all Municipal Councilors

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

WHEREAS, on March 12, 2020, the World Health Organization (WHO) declared GOVID-19 a "Pandemic";

WHEREAS, the temporary minimum fare matrix for tricycle-for-hire during the COVID-19 pandemic was enacted to avoid confusion among passengers and operators;

WHEREAS, the said guidelines for Public Transport Operations on road stated that, in areas which are under GCQ, all permitted Public Utility Vehicles, which includes all types of tricycles, transport terminals, and operators must follow three essential components dictated in the protocol/guidelines which are safety, capacity, and coverage/scope;

WHEREAS, safety refers to the guidelines that reduce contact, transmission, and spread of the virus through the mandatory use of face masks and gloves for drivers. Accordingly, thorough disinfecting practices of vehicles, terminals, and even among passengers are also required;

WHEREAS, the capacity and passenger load for a tricycle under GCQ areas based on the new protocol must not exceed one (1) passenger in the side-car, while back riding is not allowed. This is to ensure that physical distancing is followed;

WHEREAS, the one (1) passenger limit on tricycles imposed by the Guidelines will have an adverse effect on the income of the tricycle drivers and operators;

WHEREAS, in the exercise of the jurisdiction of the Municipal Government of Bayambang over tricycle operations, it is imperative to temporarily increase the minimum fare of tricycle during the MECQ/GCQ/MGCQ and other community quarantine period as may be imposed by the National Government in the Municipality of Bayambang to neutralize the adverse effects of the COVID-19 pandemic on our tricycle operators and drivers and their families.

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Bayambang recognizes that although our municipality is under Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ), public utility vehicles like tricycle are already allowed to operate, they will be doing so on a limited capacity, specifically one passenger per sidecar because of the requirements to maintain social distancing, further, the Sangguniang Bayan believes that the said policy will have an adverse effect in the income of tricycle drivers and operators;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of SB Member Martin E. Terrado II, duly seconded;

BE IT ENACTED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bayambang in session assembled that:

SECTION 1. POLICY: In compliance with the Omnibus Public Transport Protocols/Guidelines by the Department of Transportation (DOTR) and the Interagency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATFEID) covering the Road Transport sector, all tricycles shall not exceed one (1) passenger in the side-car, while back riding is not allowed.

SECTION 2. SCOPE AND LIMITATION: This Ordinance shall apply and govern all types of tricycles-for-hire, operating within the Municipality of Bayambang during the COVID-19 pandemic and MECQ/GCQ/MGCQ and other community quarantine as may be imposed by the National Government in the Municipality of Bayambang.

**SECTION 3. PRESCRIBED FARE**: The minimum fare matrix for tricycles in Municipality of Bayambang during pandemic, to wit:

- a) LIMITED PASSENGERCAPACITY: All tricycles shall be operating in a limited capacity of one (1) passenger per tricycle only and must be strictly observed to keep up with the requirement of social distancing, except in emergency cases where one (1) or two (2) companions are needed to accompany passenger in the tricycle.
- b) TRICYCLE REQUIREMENTS: To ensure and protect the health and safety of passenger as well as the driver, these physical requirements of the tricycle must be complied with, the operator may opt to add additional means in order to protect the safety of both:

- 1) Drivers shall wear protective masks/shield and gloves at all times.
- 2) A passenger is required to wear protective masks/shield at all times;
- 3) A driver should be sealed off from passenger area using no permeable, transparent material or a plastic shield that must be placed between the driver and passenger to avoid possible contamination between them while in transit;
- 4) A common box for payment/change must be provided that is placed in a visible area for both driver and passenger. A passenger is advised and encouraged to prepare and pay the exact amount of fare, if possible, to avoid further contact between the passenger and the driver;
- 5) 70% Isopropyl alcohol must be readily provided inside the tricycle for passenger use;
- 6) MANIFESTO: A logbook or clipboard and pen must be provided. The passenger is required to log in his/her name, contact no., date and time of pick-up, before a transaction is placed. The logbook will further enhance contact tracing in the event of a COVID-19 contamination. If possible, require passenger the use of their own pens if they have one; Passengers are hereby advised to keep a record of the basic details of the tricycle they have ridden such as the name of the driver, plate no., and the date and time of the riding.
- 7) Fare Matrix must be visibly displayed inside the tricycle where the passenger may be aware of;
- 8) Section 4 of this Ordinance must be visibly displayed inside the tricycle where the passenger may be informed of the new rules and tricycle fare;
- 9) Tricycles shall be disinfected every end of each trip or each and every route with all surfaces (especially seats, armrests handles, logbooks, pens) wiped down with disinfecting agent;
- 10) Drivers ID or certification that he tested negative from COVID19 rapid test must be placed in a visible place inside the tricycle for the passengers to see;
- 11) The TODA officers shall see to it that the body temperatures of the Members are being checked from time to time.

#### d) OPERATORS:

- 1) It is the responsibility of all operators to see to it that all these protective measures are strictly observed and disinfecting materials are well provided for;
- 2) Operators shall see to it that his/her drivers are fit to perform his/her duty. Should a driver show symptoms of COVID-19, he/she shall be prohibited to report or to drive the said vehicle and shall be subjected to quarantine immediately.
- e) CURFEW: Tricycle-for-hire operations are subject to curfew from 8:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.

SECTION 5. PRIVILEGES: All students, persons with disabilities, and senior citizens should be granted a special fare discount in accordance with the law granting special privileges for students, the Magna Carta for Persons with Disabilities and the Expanded Senior Citizens Act upon presentation of proper identification (ID) card.

SECTION 6. DUTIES OF THE MUNICIPAL TREASURY OFFICE (MTO): The Municipal Treasury Office being the office tasked in the implementation of this Ordinance shall:

- a. provide the new tricycle fare matrix and;
- b. ensure proper information and dissemination to all the Tricycle Operators and Drivers Associations (TODAs) in Municipality of Bayambang.
- c. All concerned tricycle operators and/or drivers shall post in their tricycles the new tricycle fare matrix, including the discounted fare of students, PWDs and senior citizens upon presentation of proper ID.

SECTION 7. ENFORCEMENT: The Bayambang Municipal Police Station and POSO hereby mandated to enforce the full extent of this Ordinance. Violators will be issued an Ordinance Violation Receipt upon apprehension.

Violators will be issued Ordinance Violation Receipt upon apprehension. Multiple violators not covered by this ordinance shall be governed by the Traffic Code of the Municipality of Bayambang (Ordinance No. 8, Series of 2010).

SECTION 8. PENALTIES: Any person violating Sections 3, 4 and 5 of this Ordinance shall be meted out the following penalties:

- 1) First (1st) Offense. The offender shall be fined P500.00 and/or shall attend community service or awareness campaigns on COVID-19 for at least three (3) hours as conducted by the barangays and other local government offices.
- 2) Second (2<sup>nd</sup>) Offense. The offender shall be fined P1,000.00 or an imprisonment of not more than thirty (30) days or both at the discretion of the courts.
- 3) Third (3<sup>rd</sup>) and subsequent offenses. The offender shall be fined P2,500.00 or an imprisonment of not more than six (6) months or both at the discretion of the courts.

SECTION 9. NO CONTEST PROVISION. Any person apprehended for violation of this Ordinance who does not wish to contest the violation and is willing to pay voluntarily the penalty imposed upon him/her prior to the filing of formal complaint shall be allowed to pay said fine with the Treasurer's Office to avoid being prosecuted.

The violator shall be given five working days from issuance of the Ordinance Violation Receipt within which to pay the fine/penalty. Otherwise, a case shall be filed against the violator.

SECTION 10. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If for any reason, any section or provision of this ordinance is declared illegal or unconstitutional, other sections or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 11. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any previously issued ordinance, or provision of this ordinance, which is inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed accordingly.

SECTION 12. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and signing, and shall remain in full force and effect during the MECQ/GCQ/MGCQ and other community quarantine as may be imposed by the National Government in the Municipality of Bayambang.

After lifting the community quarantine, the Section 4E.04, paragraph (c) of the Revenue Code of the Municipality of Bayambang (Tax Ordinance No. 2, S-2017) shall automatically take effect.
