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MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 01
SERIES OF 2021

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ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE BAYAMBANG MATALUNGGARING AWARDS: THE HIGHEST AWARD CONFERRED TO OUTSTANDING BAYAMBANGUEÑOS IN THE MUNICIPALITY;

BE IT ENACTED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bayambang in session assembled that:

Section 1. Declaration of Policy. The Municipality of Bayambang hereby institutionalize the Bayambang Matalunggaring Awards. This will be the highest recognition and honor to be conferred by the municipality upon Bayambanguenos who excels in their fields of endeavour, or had given fame or remarkable contributions to our municipality and to our country.

Section 2. Objectives. This ordinance shall have the following objectives:

- a) To provide an established system of recognizing Bayambangueno who have exceptionally distinguished themselves in their work or profession;
- b) To recognize the extraordinary and exemplary deeds, services and contributions of Bayambang to the progress and development of our municipality and our country;
- c) To inspire fellow Bayambangueno especially the youth, as these awardees have proven themselves worthy of emulation.

Section 3. Definition of Terms. For the purpose of this Ordinance, the following are defined as follows:

- a. **Bayambangueno** – a person who is born within the territorial jurisdiction of Bayambang; or whose mothers or fathers are born in Bayambang;
- b. **Posthumous Award** – refers to an award given to Outstanding Bayambangueno who had passed away.
- c. **Matalunggaring Award** – the highest award to be conferred to Bayambangueno who have exceptionally distinguished themselves in their work or profession, and have truly brought pride to the municipality.

Section 4. Committee.

- 1) The Secretariat and Screening Committee – the office of the Sangguniang Bayan Secretary shall be the Screening and Secretariat Committee. It shall be headed by the Sangguniang Bayan Secretary.
- 2) Functions. Its function are as follows:
 - a) Prepare and reproduce Nomination Forms to interested nominating persons;
 - b) Determined the completeness of the documents submitted;
 - c) Endorse all nominations and supporting documents to the Selection Committee after the deadline of submission of nominations;
 - d) Adopt an album of permanent lists of Awardees;
 - e) Shall notify the winners through official letter;
 - f) Shall plan the conduct of the awarding ceremonies;
 - g) Post publications or announcement for the awards;
- 3) The Selection Committee – The Selection Committee composed of respected individuals with proven probity and integrity shall be appointed by the municipal mayor. It shall be composed of a Chairman and four members.

Its Power and Function are as follows:

- a) finalize the criteria for judging for the Bayambang Matalunggaring Awards;
- b) shall review and validate all submitted nomination forms to ensure that all technical requirements are complied with;
- c) shall convene and deliberate on the achievements and profile of the nominees.
- d) shall select the winners and their decision will be final and unappealable;



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Section 5. Categories.

- 1) Bayambang Matalunggaring Award – given to a Bayambangueno as defined in Section 3 hereof and any of the following fields of endeavour:
 - a) Agricultural & Aquaculture
 - b) Community Development
 - c) Arts
 - d) Banking
 - e) Law
 - f) Community Development
 - g) Economics
 - h) Education
 - i) Government Service
 - j) Journalism
 - k) Sports
 - l) Literature
 - m) Medicine
 - n) Science and Technology
 - o) Business
 - p) Other Relevant Fields
- 2) Posthumous Award – the awards may be given posthumously to any individual entitled thereto, in which case it shall be received by his/her legal heirs or by his/her nearest kin.

Section 6. Qualifications. The qualifications for the awards are:

- 1) A Nominee must be:
 - a) A natural-born Bayambangueno who was born within the territorial jurisdiction of Bayambang;
 - b) Those wherever born in the Philippines or in a foreign country. In this case, the father or the mother be a natural born or naturalized citizen of the Philippines and a Bayambangueno;
 - c) Bayambangueno whose domicile is in Bayambang.

Section 7. Requirements for Nomination. The following requirements shall be submitted and should be arranged in the following order:

- 1) Certification and Consent From of Nominator;
- 2) Nomination Form with a passport-size photograph of nominee;
- 3) Certification of no derogatory records;
- 4) A certified true copy of the nominee's birth certificate or any equivalent proof of date and place of birth should accompany the nomination form. If the nominees is an alien, a certified true copy of birth certificate of father or mother shall be submitted;
- 5) Nominee's photograph (5'7") – (2 copies)
- 6) Nominee's Resume
- 7) Executive Summary
- 8) List of Accomplishments/Activities/Published Woks (with sample)
- 9) List of Awards and Recognitions Received (certified copy)
- 10) Supporting photos with captions

All information and documents received by the Secretariat will be treated with utmost confidentiality. Nominations received, including attachments, materials and other supporting documents shall become property of the LGU-Bayambang and shall not be returned.

The selection and screening committee and secretariat members shall not provide information on the status of nomination and committee deliberations and are bound by a non-disclosure agreement throughout the awards period.



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Section 8. Disqualifications. The disqualifications for the awards are:

- a) Those sentenced by final judgment or offense involving moral turpitude or for an offense punishable by one (1) year or more of imprisonment or two (2) years of serving sentence punishable under the revised penal code;
- b) Those removed from office as a result of an administrative case;
- c) Misrepresentation or falsification of information stated in the nomination form or in any of the supporting documents will result in the automatic and perpetual disqualification of the nominee;
- d) Nominees or nominator requesting member/s of the Selection and Screening Committee and/or member/s of the Secretariat, directly or thru intermediaries, special favor or consideration;
- e) Those convicted by final judgment for violating an oath of the Republic of the Philippines;
- f) Fugitive from justice in criminal or non-political cases here and abroad;
- g) The insane or feeble-minded;
- h) Incumbent appointed or elected municipal officials and employees are disqualified to be nominated in his/her capacity as a public servant.

Section 9. Nominations. Nomination may be made by:

- 1) Private individuals
- 2) Members of the Academe
- 3) Religious Institutions
- 4) Non-government organizations
- 5) Previous nominees who are not recipients of the award may be re-nominated under the same or other award categories. Nominees from the previous awards year who are re-nominated for the current year will be evaluated equally with the other new nominees and must provide new accomplishments and contributions other than those cited in the previous nomination.

Section 10. Repealing Clause. All Ordinances, Resolutions, Executive Orders, Memorandum Circulars and Administrative Orders or parts thereof which are inconsistent with any provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 11. Separability Clause. If for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional, invalid, illegal or unenforceable the other provisions not declared and not affected by such declaration shall remain in full force and effect.


Article 12. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Pangasinan.
