EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 011 Series of 2016

"REORGANIZING/RECONSTITUTING THE MUNICIPAL ANTI-DRUG ABUSE COORDINATING COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYAMBANG, PANGASINAN"

WHEREAS, the 1987 Philippine Constitution mandates that the government shall promote the quality of life of the people;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code provides that local government units shall pursue undertakings to improve public morals and maintain peace and order, among other equally significant concerns;

WHEREAS, the increasing use of illegal drugs has significantly contributed to the incidence of heinous crimes.

WHEREAS, the problem on illegal drugs has to be addressed much more effectively to help ensure community peace and harmony;

WHEREAS, DILG Memorandum Circular No. 98-227 dated December 2, 1998, as amended, enjoins local government units to create their Local Anti-Drug Abuse Councils;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CEZAR T. QUIAMBAO, Municipal Mayor of the Municipality of Bayambang, Pangasinan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby reorganize/reconstitute the Municipal Anti-Drug Abuse Coordinating Council of the Municipality of Bayambang, Pangasinan as follows:

Section 1. Composition.

Section 2. Roles and Responsibilities.

- A. Serve as a focal point through which various organizations and individuals work together cooperatively in the planning, implementation and evaluation of programs on the drug abuse prevention.
- B. Provide for an effective mechanism for the coordination of existing services and programs and those which might be developed in the immediate future.
- C. Provide for a mechanism to obtain funds, volunteers, facilities and technical expertise; and
- D. Perform other related responsibilities as may be assigned by competent authorities.

Section 3. Effectivity.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
