

MUNICIPAL MAYOR OF BAYAMBANG

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 013 Series of 2016

"REORGANIZING/RECONSTITUING THE MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYAMBANG, PANGASINAN"

WHEREAS, Section 12 under Article 1 of Republic Act. No. 9003 provides for the creation of Municipal Solid Waste Management Board that shall prepare, submit and implement plan for the safe and sanitary management of solid waste generated in areas its geographic and political coverage;

WHEREAS, the increasing volume of garbage is posing a serious threat to the general welfare and health of the people, as well as to the integrity of the environment;

WHEREAS, this health and environmental problem requires utmost attention and cooperation among the concerned national government agencies, local government units, business community, civil society and the people in general;

NOW, THEREFORE I, CEZAR T. QUIAMBAO, Municipal Mayor of the Municipality of Bayambang, Pangasinan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby reorganize/reconstitute the Municipal Solid Waste Management Board of the Municipality of Bayambang, Pangasinan as follows:

Section 1.Composition.

The Municipal Solid Waste Management Board (MSWMB) shall be composed of the following:

Section 2 Duties and Responsibilities.

The Municipal Solid Waste Management Board shall perform the following:

- A. Develop the Municipal Solid Waste Management Plan that shall ensure the long-term management of solid waste, as well as integrate the various solid waste management plans and strategies of the barangays I it's area of jurisdiction. In the development of the Solid Waste Management Plan, it shall conduct consultations with the various sectors of the community;
- B. Adopt measures to promote and ensure the viability and effective implementation of solid waste management programs in its component barangays;
- C. Monitor the implementation of the Municipal Solid Waste Management Plan through its various political subdivisions and in cooperation with the private sectors and the NGOs;

- D. Adopt specific revenue-generating measures to promote the viability of its Solid Waste Management Plan;
- E. Convene regular meetings for purposes of planning and coordinating the implementation of the solid waste management plans of the respective component barangays;
- F. Oversee the implementation of the Municipal Solid Waste Management Plan;
- G. Review every two (2) or as the need arises the Municipal Solid Waste Management Plan for purposes of ensuring its sustainability, viability, effectiveness and relevance In relation to local and international developments in the field of solid waste management
- Develop the specific mechanic and guidelines for the implementation of the Municipal Solid Waste Management Plan;
- Recommend to appropriate local government authorities' specific measures or proposals for franchise or build-operate-transfer agreements with duly recognized institutions, pursuant to R.A 6957, to provide either exclusive or non-exclusive authority for the collection, transfer, storage, processing, recycling or disposal of city solid waste. The proposals shall take into consideration appropriate government rules and regulations on contracts, franchises and buildoperate-transfer agreements;
- Provide the necessary logistical and operational support to its components barangays in consonance with subsection (f) of Section 17 of Local Government Code;
- K. Recommend measures and safeguards against population and for the preservation of the natural ecosystem;
- L. Coordinate the efforts of all components barangays in the implementation of the Municipal Solid Waste Management Plan; and
- M. Call on any concerned agency or sector, as it may deem necessary, for support or other appropriate action.

Section 3. Meetings and Quorum.

The Municipal Solid Waste Management Board shall meet at least once a month or often as may be necessary. A majority of the members of the Board shall constitute a quorum. The Chairman must be present when budgetary proposals are prepared and the affirmative vote of all majority of its members shall be necessary for the purpose.

Section 4.Effectivity.

This executive order shall take effect immediately.
