EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 35 SERIES OF 2018

CANCELLATION OF CLASSES FROM PRESCHOOL TO SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL IN BOTH PRIVATE AND PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYAMBANG

WHEREAS, Presidential Executive Order No. 66 series of 2012 entitled “Prescribing Rules on the Cancellation or Suspension of Classes and Work in Government Offices Due to Typhoons, Flooding, Other Weather Disturbances and Calamities” empowers the Local Chief Executive to declare the localized cancellation or suspension of classes in both private and public schools in the absence of typhoon signal warnings from PAGASA;

WHEREAS, PDRRMC Memorandum No. 8 empowers the Local Chief Executive to suspend classes on Wednesday, August 15, 2018 as there are varying hazard situations among cities/municipalities of the Province of Pangasinan;

WHEREAS, due to incessant rains brought by the SOUTHWEST MONSOON or HABAGAT over the past few days have caused immense flooding among areas in the Municipality of Bayambang, Pangasinan, and due to rapid increase of water volume in San Roque Power Corporation and subsequent dam discharge with a total gate opening of 6.5 meters;

NOW THEREFORE, by virtue of the powers vested in me as Local Chief Executive, I hereby declare the **cancellation of classes from preschool to senior high school in both public and private schools on August 15, 2018 in the Municipality in order to prevent the risk of and loss of life and property.**

Everyone is advised to take precautionary measures to avoid any untoward incident. All Punong Barangays of the affected areas are hereby advised to mobilize their respective Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council to monitor the situation in their area of jurisdiction.
