EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 41 SERIES OF 2018

CANCELLATION OF CLASSES IN ALL LEVELS OF BOTH PRIVATE AND PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND WORK IN GOVERNMENT OFFICES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYAMBANG

WHEREAS, **Presidential Executive Order No. 66 series of 2012**, empowers the Local Chief Executive to declare the **localized cancellation or suspension of classes and work in government offices** in the absence of typhoon signal warnings from PAGASA;

WHEREAS, the Province of Pangasinan has already been placed by the Department of Interior and Local Government under **ALERT LEVEL BRAVO** due to the anticipated onslaught of **TYPHOON "OMPONG"**;

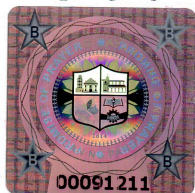
WHEREAS, preparations are necessary to weather the anticipated heavy to intense rains and gustiness of the incoming typhoon;

NOW THEREFORE, by virtue of the powers vested in me as Local Chief Executive, I hereby declare the **cancellation of classes in all levels in both public and private schools and suspension of work in all government offices on September 14, 2018 (Friday)** in the Municipality in order to prevent the risk of and loss of life and property. Offices involved in essential services and disaster preparedness (ESWMO, Market, POSO, MDRRMO, RHU I & II, etc.) are to continue operations.

Everyone is advised to take precautionary measures to avoid any untoward incident. All Punong Barangays that had been already advised to mobilize their respective Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council are hereby enjoined to monitor the situation in their area of jurisdiction.
