EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 43 Series of 2018

CANCELLATION OF CLASSES IN ALL LEVELS OF BOTH PRIVATE AND PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYAMBANG

WHEREAS, Presidential Executive Order No. 66 series of 2012 empowers the Local Chief Executive to declare the localized cancellation or suspension of classes in both private and public schools in the absence of typhoon signal warnings from PAGASA;

WHEREAS, due to the intense rains brought about by TYPHOON "OMPONG" sporadic flooding is being experienced in the Municipality's low-lying barangays. To make matters worse, San Roque Dam Corporation had continuously released voluminous water by **opening up to four (4) dam gates with water discharges of up to twelve (12) meters from September 15-16, 2018** with the result of more water flowing to the already swollen Agno River;

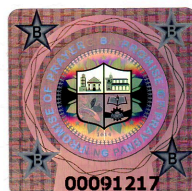
WHEREAS, in order to ensure the safety of the townspeople particularly the pupils and students, there is a need to declare a localized cancellation of classes on September 17, 2018;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, DR. CEZAR T. QUIAMBAO, by virtue of powers vested in me as Local Chief Executive, I hereby declare the **cancellation of classes in all levels in both public and private schools on September 17, 2018.**

Everyone is advised to take precautionary measures to avoid any untoward incident. All Punong Barangays and BDRRMCs are advised to continue monitoring their respective areas of jurisdiction and to take precautionary measures including but not limited to the pre-emptive or forced evacuation of affected barangays.
