EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 51

Series of 2020

“AN ORDER EXTENDING THE LOCKDOWN OF THE BAYAMBANG PUBLIC MARKET (BLOCK III)”

WHEREAS, on September 15, 2020, the Municipality of Bayambang recorded a spike in confirmed COVID-19 cases with twelve (12) individuals showing positive results in their RT-PCR test;

WHEREAS, all 12 patients were close contacts of the deceased meat vendor from the Bayambang Public Market who tested positive for COVID-19 on August 31, 2020;

WHEREAS, by virtue of Executive Order No. 45, s. 2020, the Meat & Fish Section (Block III), along with the Canteen, of the Bayambang Public Market was placed on lockdown from September 10, 2020 to September 16, 2020 to give way for decontamination operations;

WHEREAS, at least twenty-four (24) vendors, stall tenants, and staff at the Meat Section of the Bayambang Public Market are still awaiting the results of their RT-PCR tests,

WHEREAS, the foregoing calls for the intensification of measures to contain the spread of COVID-19 in the municipality;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, DR. CEZAR T. QUIAMBAO, by virtue of the powers vested in me as the Municipal Mayor of Bayambang, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. Extension of the lockdown of the Bayambang Public Market (Block III).

The lockdown of the Meat & Fish Section and Canteen, including Cely's Canteen, of the Bayambang Public Market shall be extended until September 24, 2020. It shall be re-opened on September 25, 2020 (5AM).

SECTION 2. Decontamination operations. The Meat & Fish Section, along with the Canteen, of the Bayambang Public Market shall undergo another massive cleaning and decontamination operation.

SECTION 3. Extension of the temporary market operations. The temporary market located in Brgy. Bani, Bayambang, Pangasinan shall remain operational until the lockdown of the Bayambang Public Market is lifted. Vendors at the Meat & Fish Section of the Public Market are still prohibited from selling their goods at the temporary market.

SECTION 4. Mandatory quarantine of meat vendors. All vendors stationed at the Meat Section of the Bayambang Public Market are mandated to undergo strict home quarantine starting on September 17, 2020 until September 24, 2020 and/or until the results of their RT-PCR tests come back as negative.

SECTION 5. Enforcement. All barangay officials, with the help of PNP-Bayambang and LGU Bayambang, through the Public Order and Safety Office and other delegated local enforcers, are mandated to ensure compliance to the full extent and the strict execution of this Order.

SECTION 6. Penalty for violators. Any person who unreasonably refuses to abide by or deliberately violates this order shall face a penalty in accordance with those provided under Section 10 of RA 11332, otherwise known as Mandatory Reporting of Notifiable Diseases and Health Events of Public Health Concern Act, for non-cooperation, and such other applicable laws, rules, and ordinances.

SECTION 7. Separability Clause. If any provision of the Executive Order is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain valid and subsisting.

SECTION 8. Repealing Clause. All other orders, rules, regulations and issuances, or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with this Order are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 9. Effectivity Clause. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect unless sooner revoked or amended.

Let copies of this Order be furnished to all offices, departments, and barangays for their information and appropriate action.
