EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 03 Series of 2021

AN ORDER CREATING THE TASK FORCE "BAKUNA" IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYAMBANG, PROVINCE OF PANGASINAN

WHEREAS, Section 15, Article II of the 1987 Constitution states that: "The State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them";

WHEREAS, Local Government Units, being pollical subdivisions of the State, is mandated under the Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, to "exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, under Section 444 (b) (1) (vii) of the Local Government Code of 1991, the Municipal Mayor is authorized to carry out such emergency measures as may be necessary during and in the aftermath of man-made and natural disasters and calamities;

WHEREAS, on January 7, 2021, the Bayambang CoViD-19 Inter-Agency Task Force, convened with the agenda of the Creation of Task Force "Bakuna";

WHEREAS, in light of the emergence of Vaccination Road Map of the National Government, the creation of a Task Force for the implementation of the Nationwide Vaccination against CoViD-19 is warranted;

NOW THEREFORE, I, DR. CEZAR T. QUIAMBAO, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law as the Municipal Mayor of Bayambang, Pangasinan, do hereby ORDER THE CREATION OF TASK FORCE "BAKUNA", TO WIT:

SECTION 1. CREATION OF TASK FORCE "BAKUNA". A Task Force to be known as Task Force "Bakund" is hereby created in the Municipality.

SECTION 2. COMPOSITION. The Task Force shall have the following composition:

SECTION 3. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES. The Task Force shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

- a. Formulate and develop plans, programs and activities for the implementation of the vaccination program against CoViD-19 or its variants;
- b. Coordinate with the component barangays for the implementation of the plans, programs and activities
- c. Conduct a survey and identify the residents who are willing to undergo vaccination against CoViD-19 or its variants;
- d. Manage, coordinate and supervise the implementation of the vaccination program against CoViD-19 or its variants
- e. Submit recommendations to the Local Chief Executive for appropriate measures and orders.

SECTION 4. SECRETARIAT. A Secretariat of the Task Force composed of Mr. Rafael Saygo and Patricia Espino is hereby created to assist the Task Force in the exercise of its functions like the recording of its proceedings, transcribing the records of the proceedings, preparation and furnishing copies of notices, orders, and other processes to the concerned parties, and perform such other incidental and inherent administrative functions.

SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of the Executive Order is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain valid and subsisting.

SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. All other orders, rules, regulations and issuances, or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with this Order, are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect unless sooner revoked or amended.

Let copies of this Order be furnished to Offices and Departments concerned including but not limited to, the DILG and Inter Agency Task Force, the Philippine National Police and all Barangays for their information and guidance. Further, let copies of this Order be furnished to the neighboring Municipalities for their information and appropriate action.
