EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 27

AN ORDER CREATING AN OFFICIAL COMMUNICATIONS GROUP FOR CONCERNS REGARDING LOCALLY STRANDED INDIVIDUALS AMIDST THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Bayambang is placed under Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ) in light of the COVID-19 pandemic;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Bayambang resolves concerns daily regarding individuals arriving in the municipality;

WHEREAS, physical distancing and other measures must be implemented in order to further curb the cases in the municipality;

WHEREAS, social media is used as an effective means of communication to limit face-to-face meetings and prevent the possible spread of the virus;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, DR. CEZAR T. QUIAMBAO, by virtue of the powers vested in me as the Municipal Mayor of Bayambang, do hereby order the creation of an official communications group for concerns regarding Locally Stranded Individuals (LSIs) with the following provisions:

SECTION 1. FUNCTION. The communications group – to be officially called the LSI Core Group – shall attend to all matters concerning LSIs arriving to and departing from the Municipality of Bayambang. The group shall spearhead programs of the Local Government Unit for LSIs to ensure the safety of all people from the probable spread of COVID-19.

SECTION 2. COMPOSITION. The LSI Core Group shall be composed of the following members:

SECTION 4. Repealing Clause. All other orders, rules, regulations and issuances, or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with this Order are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 5. Effectivity Clause. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect unless sooner revoked or amended.


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
