AMENDMENT TO EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 014, SERIES OF 2022 "AN ORDER CREATING THE COUNCIL AND TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP OF THE WATER, SANITATION, AND HYGIENE (WASH) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYAMBANG, PANGASINAN"

WHEREAS, in compliance with Section 17 of Republic Act 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991, on the provision of Basic Service and Facilities, Local Government Units shall endeavor to be self-reliant and shall continue exercising the powers and discharging the duties and functions currently vested upon them;

WHEREAS, Local Government Units shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provisions of the basic services and facilities enumerated herein;

WHEREAS, The LGU shall create and establish a group that shall act as the local oversight body on the water, sanitation, and hygiene (WASH) matters in the whole locality;

WHEREAS, The LGU shall integrate, promote and develop plans, programs and projects for the water and sanitation sector at the local level, with priority given to poor communities without access to safe drinking water;

WHEREAS, water development and management should be based on a participatory approach, involving users, planners, and policymakers at all levels;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARY CLARE JUDITH PHYLLIS JOSE-QUIAMBAO, Municipal Mayor of Bayambang, Province of Pangasinan, by virtue of powers vested upon me by law do hereby order the Creation of the Bayambang Water Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) Council and Technical Working Group in the Municipality of Bayambang, Pangasinan:

SECTION 1. CREATION AND COMPOSITION OF THE COUNCIL. The Water Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) Council shall be composed of the following:

SECTION 2. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE COUNCIL. The Water Sanitation and Hygiene Council shall perform the following responsibilities:

- 1. Serve as local oversight and policy-making body on the integrated safe water, sanitation, and hygiene (WASH);
- 2. Formulate and implement the Municipal Water Supply and Sanitation Plan where WASH targets and investments are included in the Annual Investment Program (AIP), Comprehensive Development Plan (CDP), and Comprehensive Land Use Plan (CLUP);
- 3. Formulate and pass local policies to support the promotion, advocacy, implementation, and sustainability of WASH plans, projects, and programs in the municipality;
- 4. Ensure that gender equality and women empowerment, Climate Change Adaption (CCA), Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR), and Public-Private Partnership (PPP) are integrated with WASH policies, plans, programs, and projects;
- 5. Ensure integrity of local citizens to safe water, sanitation, and hygiene i.e. establish mechanisms for local participation, feed-backing, monitoring, and reporting on WASH issues and concerns;
- 6. Identify areas for development and recommendations to enhance access and provision of safe water, sanitation, and hygiene service to target communities, especially among women and girls; and
- 7. Ensure that the performance of the Water Users Association (WUA)/ Water Service Provider (WSP) is regularly evaluated in terms of providing quality, adequate, affordable, and continuous safe water, sanitation, and hygiene services.

SECTION 4. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP. The Water Sanitation and Hygiene Technical Working Group (WASH-TWG) shall perform the following responsibilities:

- 1. Supervise, monitor, and report to the WASH Council the progress of implementation of programs, plans, and projects on WASH.;
- 2. Implement, monitor, and report to the WASH Council achievement of safe water sanitation and hygiene set in the LGU WASH Sector plan as needed i.e. increased WASH coverage, decrease in reported cases of water-borne diseases, the attainment of Zero Open Defecation in barangays, among others;
- 3. Work in close coordination with the Regional WATSAN Hub for the provision of capacity development assistance on LGU programs/ projects on WASH;

- 4. Assist the Bottled Water Association (BWA) to set up systems, procedures, and laws that would sustain operations and maintenance of the WASH facilities and make available mechanisms for community consultation, reporting, and feedbacking;
- 5. Regularly monitor and assess the performance of BWA to ensure the delivery of adequate, affordable, quality, and continuous services on safe water sanitation and hygiene; and
- 6. Other duties and responsibilities may be assigned by the council.

SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of the Executive Order is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain valid and subsisting.

SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. All orders, rules, regulations, and issuances, or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with this Order, are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately and remain in effect unless revoked or amended sooner.
