### EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 38

### “CREATION OF THE MUNICIPAL SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY COORDINATING COUNCIL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAYAMBANG, PROVINCE OF PANGASINAN”

**WHEREAS** Section 10 Article XIV of the 1987 Philippine Constitution states that, “Science and technology are essential for national development and progress. The State shall give priority to research and development, invention, innovation, and their utilization, and to science and technology, education, training and services period. It shall support indigenous, appropriate, and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, and their application to the country’s productive systems and national life”;

**WHEREAS** Research and Development (**R&D**) focus its research outputs on addressing the country’s issues on inequality, employment, and economic competitiveness;

**WHEREAS** the Department of Science and Technology (**DOST**) is the primary agency mandated to provide central direction, leadership and coordination of scientific and technological efforts and ensure that the results therefrom are geared and utilized in areas of maximum economic and social benefits for the people;

**WHEREAS**, to fully implement the Projects, Programs, and Activities of the Local Government Unit (**LGU**) concerning Science and Technology, the Creation of the Municipal Science and Technology Coordinating Council (**MSTCC**) is imperative.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARY CLARE JUDITH PHYLLIS JOSE-QUIAMBAO**, Municipal Mayor of Bayambang, Province Pangasinan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby create and organize the Municipal Science and Technology Coordinating Council of the Municipality of Bayambang with the following:

**SECTION 1. Creation:** There shall be created a Municipal Science and Technology Coordinating Council tasked to coordinate, harmonize, and monitor the implementation of all plans, programs and projects in the field of science and technology in the Municipality.

**SECTION 2. Composition:** The Municipal Science and Technology Coordinating Council (**MSTCC**) shall be composed of the following:

**SECTION 3. Duties and Responsibilities:**

The Municipal Science and technology Coordinating Council shall:

1. Formulate and adopt a comprehensive Municipal Science and Technology Plan;
2. Promote public awareness on Science and Technology Plan;
3. Encourage and facilitate the active participation of the community in scientific and technological activities;
4. Establish and partnership with other sectors in promoting development of indigenous materials available in the locality and in strengthening scientific and technological capability by the various sectors in the municipality; and
5. Undertake activities to promote technological services needed in agriculture, industry, academe, and the general public.

**SECTION 4. Secretariat:** The Secretariat shall be headed by **Dr. Rafael L. Saygo** and shall perform the following functions:

1. Prepares the minutes, agenda and records the attendance and proceedings of all meetings of the council;
2. Serves notice of meetings to all members of the council;
3. Furnishes the officers and members certified copies of the minutes of the meetings;
4. Keeps a register of the names and addresses of all members and keeps a complete file of the laws, resolutions and executive orders relevant to the creation of the council; and
5. In general, perform all duties incidental to the Office of the Secretariat

**SECTION 5. Meeting of the Council:** The Council shall meet quarterly; provided however that the Chairman may convene the Council anytime whenever deem necessary.

**SECTION 6. Funding.** The fund needed to implement the various Program, Projects and Activities concerning Science and Technology shall be incorporated in the Annual Appropriations of the Local Government Unit.

**SECTION 7. Separability Clause:** Any portion or provision of the Executive Order that maybe declared unconstitutional shall not have the effect of nullifying other portions or provisions hereof as long as such remaining portions or provisions can still subsist and be given effect in their entirety.

**SECTION 8. Repealing Clause:** All orders, laws, ordinances, rules and regulations, other issuances or any part thereof, which are inconsistent with this Executive Order are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 9. EFFECTIVELY:**

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
